Statistics

- 82 students are utilizing disability accommodations this semester.
 - 46% are New Students who are utilizing accommodations for the first time at OSU-OKC.
 - 54% are Current/Returning Students who have utilized accommodations before at OSU-OKC.

Primary Student Disabilities

1. Cognitive/Learning (39%)
2. Mental Health (33%)
3. Other (10%)
4. Chronic Medical Conditions (9%)
5. Neurological/Neuromuscular/Mobility (9%)
6. Sensory (7%)

Student Disability Accommodations Provided

1. Extended time on timed tests, exams, and quizzes (95%)
2. Reasonable flexibility in attendance policies and/or coursework due dates in order to manage medical episodes or to attend health care appointments related to their disability (37%)
3. Permission to audio-record class lectures for note-taking purposes only (22%)
4. Other accommodations (17%)
5. Reader/Scribe on exams, quizzes, or inaccessible coursework (4%)
6. Captioned media (1%)

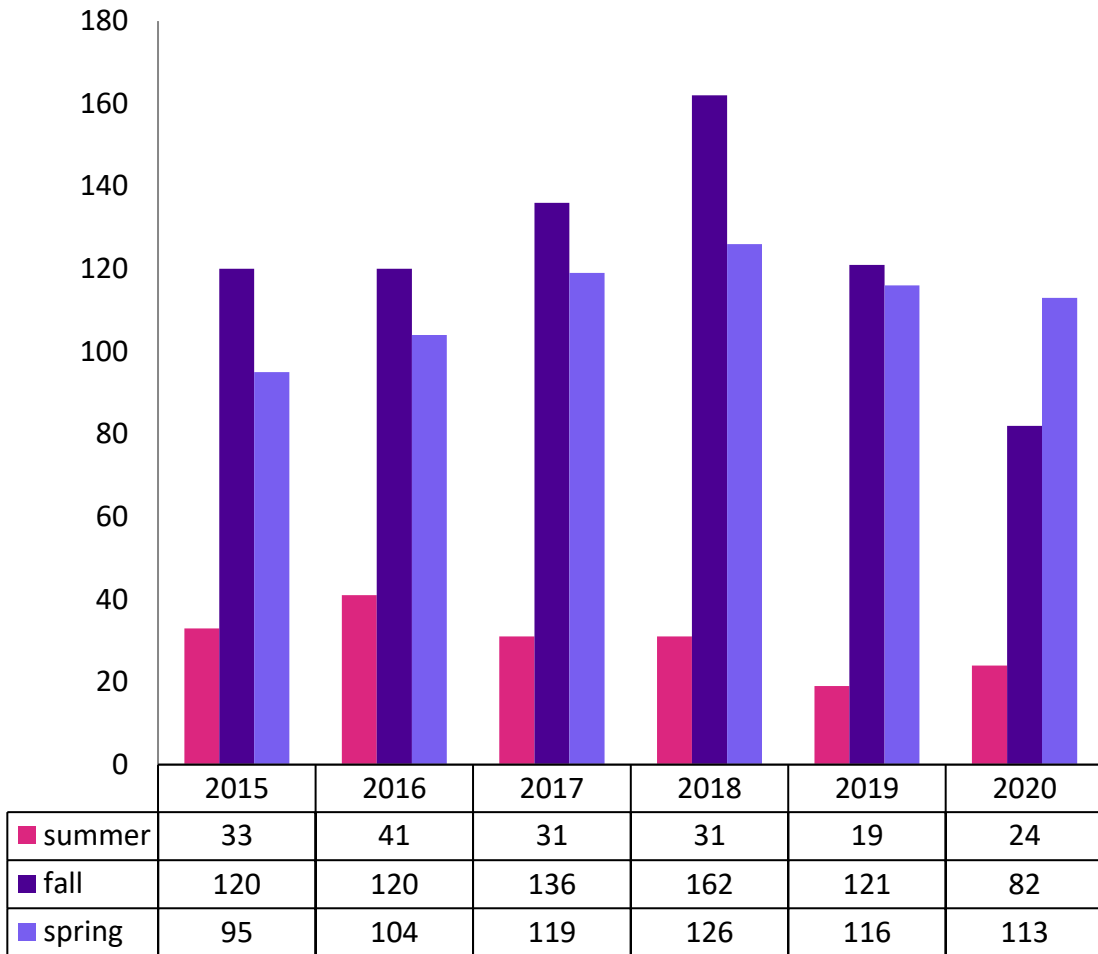


Figure 2: Primary Disabilities of Students Utilizing Disability Accommodations in Fall 2020

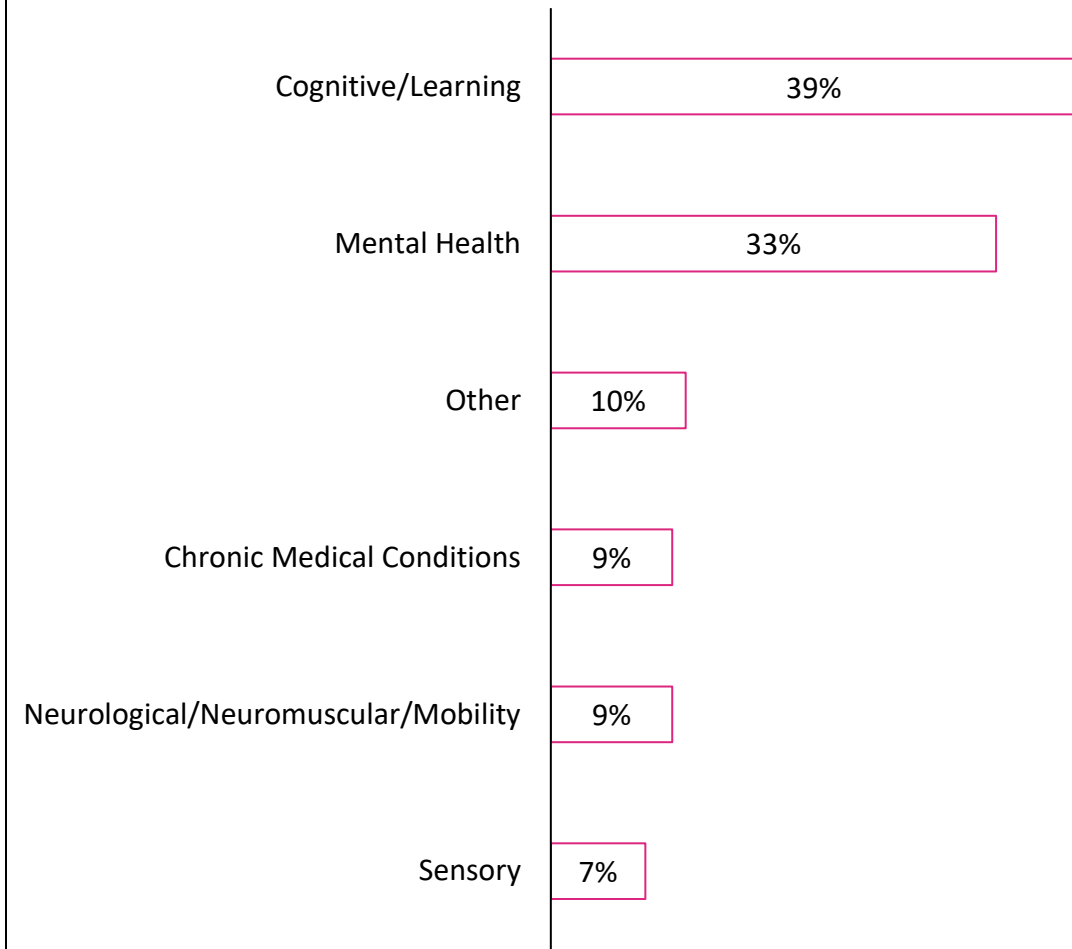


Figure 3: Student Disability Accommodations Provided in Fall 2020
