Statistics

- 25 students are utilizing disability accommodations this semester.
 - 40% are New Students who are utilizing accommodations for the first time at OSU-OKC.
 - 60% are Current/Returning Students who have utilized accommodations before at OSU-OKC.

Primary Disabilities of Students Utilizing Accommodations

1. Cognitive/Learning (52%)
2. Mental Health (32%)
3. Chronic Medical Conditions (12%)
4. Sensory (12%)
5. Neurological/Neuromuscular/Mobility (8%)
6. Other (4%)

Types of Student Disability Accommodations Provided

1. Extended time on timed tests, exams, and quizzes (92%)
2. Reasonable flexibility in attendance policies and/or coursework due dates in order to manage medical episodes or to attend health care appointments related to their disability (40%)
3. Permission to audio-record class lectures for note-taking purposes only (32%)
4. Other accommodations (16%)
5. Reader/Scribe on exams, quizzes, or inaccessible coursework (12%)
6. Sign Language Interpreter and Captioned media (4%)

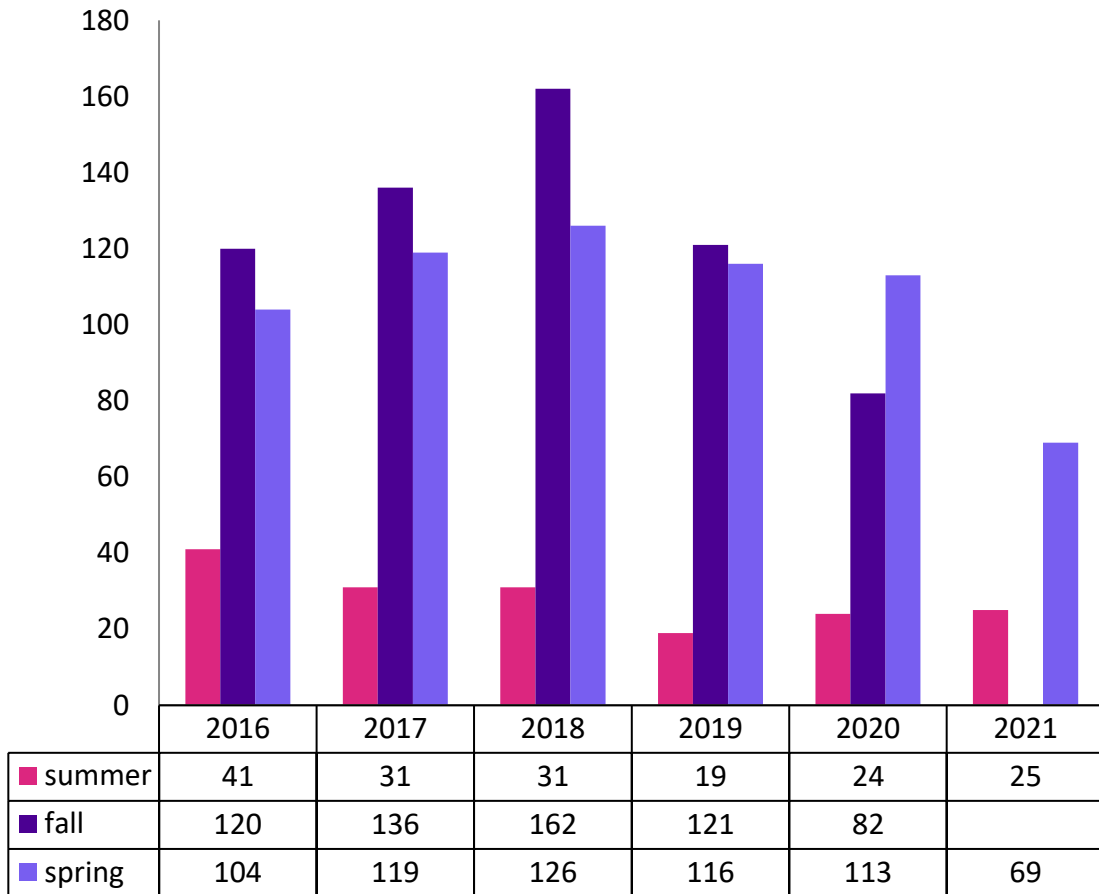


Figure 2: Primary Disabilities of Students Utilizing Accommodations Summer 2021

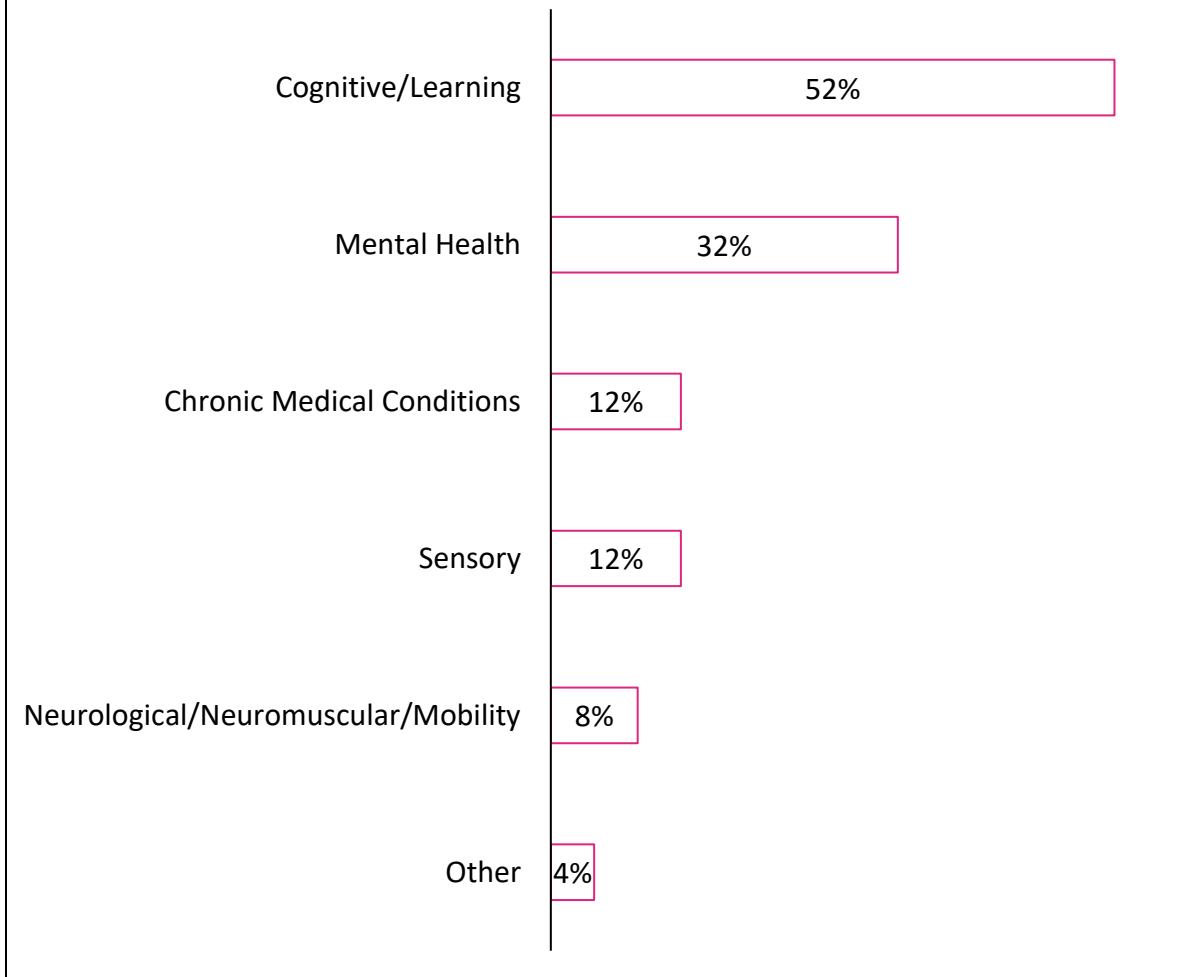


Figure 3: Types of Student Disability Accommodations Provided Summer 2021
