

Cell Phone Use

in the OSU-OKC Library

• The OSU-Oklahoma City Library is a place for quiet research, consultation and study. Appropriate conduct is expected from all that use the facilities.

Owners of cell phones will be expected to turn phone ringers off, or turn them down to their lowest level while in the Library. If cell phone use is required, users will be expected to move to a location away from fellow students so conversations will not disturb others. Loud conversation is both unnecessary and unacceptable. Extensive cell phone conversation while in the library is discouraged. Offensive language is unacceptable in the Library at any time.

There is a charging station located at the stairway entrance. Please turn your ringers off or on 'silent' if you leave your device to charge. Please do not sit at the charging station for a phone conversation during its charging.

Please do not use cell phones in the Library Network area at any time.

Failure to comply with this policy will result in cellular telephones being banned altogether in the Library.
