# Copy Machine

The OSU-Oklahoma City Library has a copy machine for student use. Copies are  $5\phi$  per page. The copy machine will accept nickels, dimes, and quarters as well as one and five dollar bills.

### **Collaboration Room**

Up to 4 devices can be connected to share on the big screen monitor. This room can be reserved through the Circulation Desk for a group of at least 3 persons needing the equipment. Ask at the Desk for more information.

## Copy & Supply Center

Located near the Library Network, the Copy & Supply Center has a pencil sharpener, paper clips, pencils, scratch paper, tape, a 3-hole punch and a paper cutter.

# **Printing**

There are two laser printers in the Copy & Supply Center for all network printing. There is a separate printer for the computers by the main Library entrance and the Disability Enhanced computers. A fourth printer is set up for printing from Library laptops. Printing problems will be handled at the Circulation Desk. PowerPoint printing should be set up as 6 slides per page. You may have color printing done by the staff for 75¢ per page. For instructions, talk to someone at the Circulation Desk and allow a few minutes for each request.

#### **OK-Share Card**

An "OK-Share Card" may be obtained at the Circulation Desk. You must be a currently enrolled student at OSU-Oklahoma City. This card will enable you to utilize library services at about 40 other colleges and universities throughout Oklahoma. This card must be renewed each semester.
